The UNC Police Department serves and protects 365 days a year, 24 hours a day.

The UNC Police Department's greatest goal is to provide customer focused and problem solving services in partnership with the diverse community it serves. The UNC Police Department strives to achieve this goal through community oriented policing (COP) efforts which includes COP programming, crime prevention and fostering relationships with the community on and off campus.

Every sworn officer meets the requirements set forth by the North Carolina Criminal Justice Education & Training Standards Commission. The UNC Police Department enforces federal, state and local laws as well University policies on all properties they have jurisdictional authority. UNC Police Officers have the opportunity to make a real difference in someone's life in a positive manner.

JOINING THE DEPARTMENT

The UNC Chapel Hill Police Department is currently hiring candidates at three different career points:
